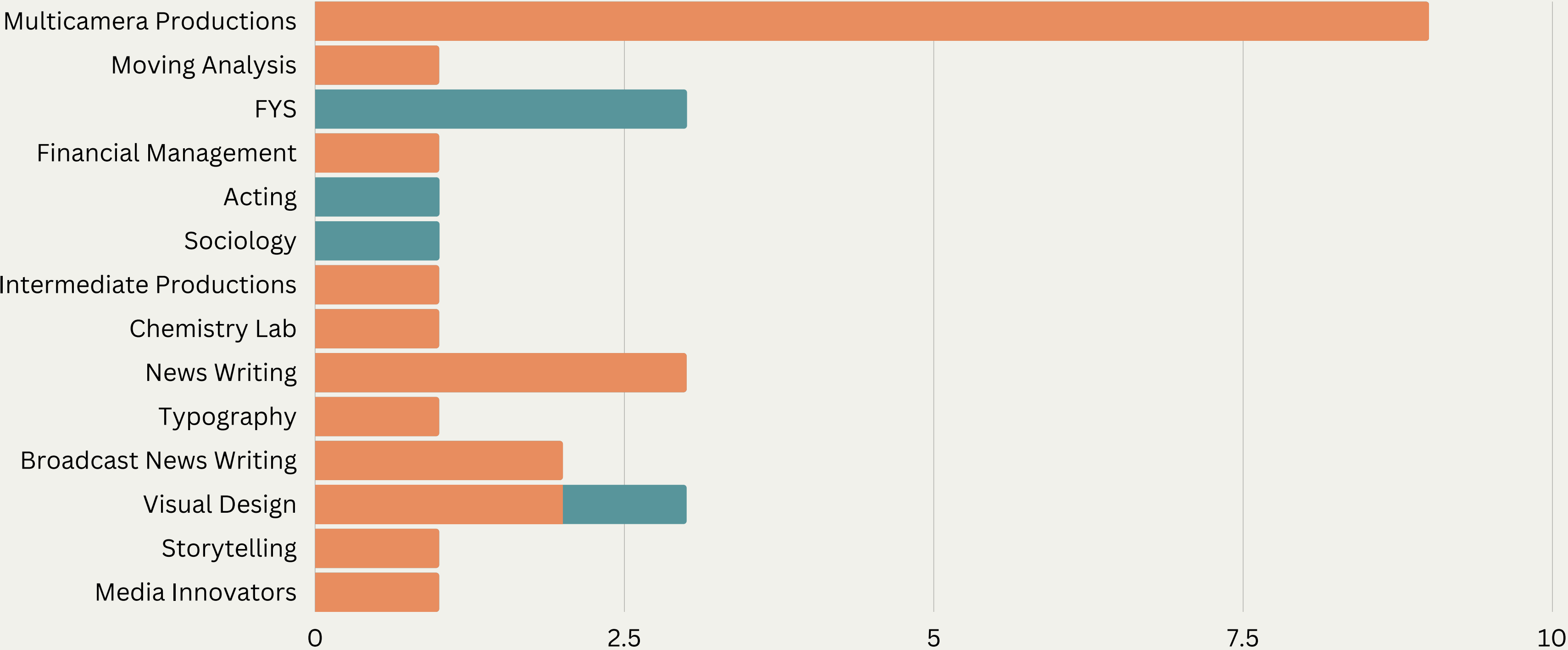
Hardest / "Dreaded the Most" Courses

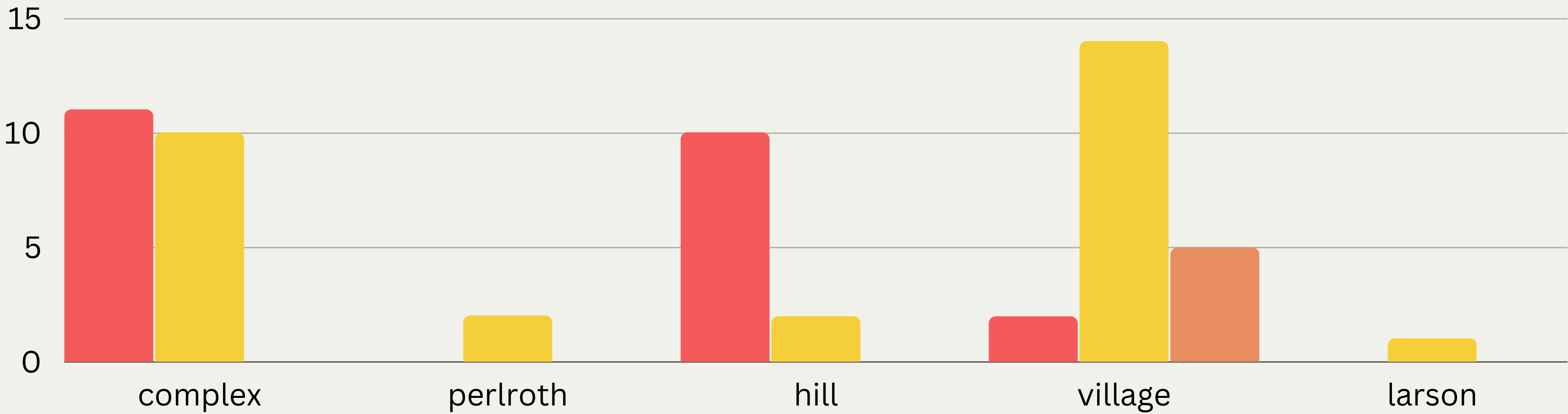

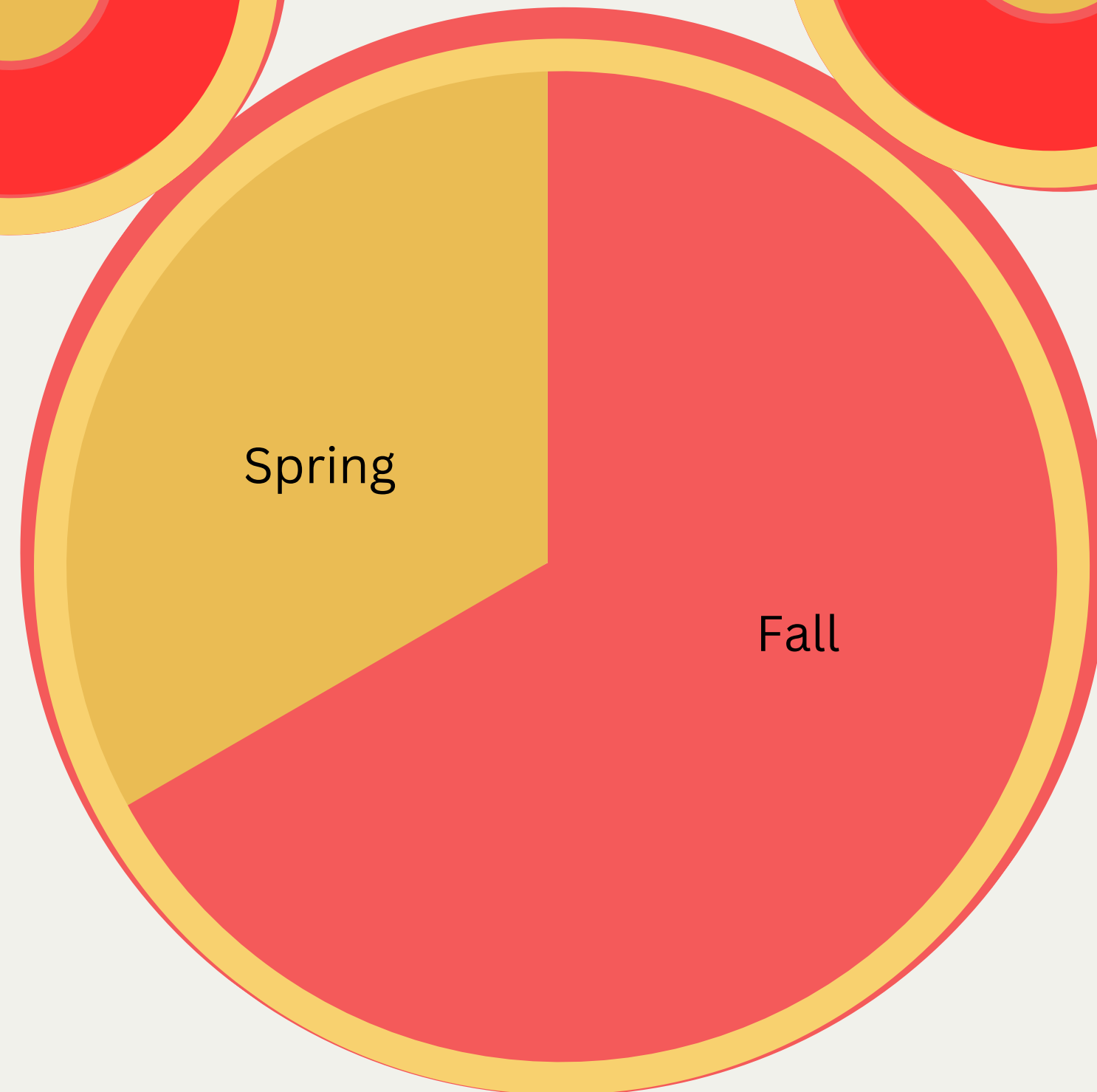
